 <p><b>Aimovig® (erenumab) for the prevention of migraine: A guide for community pharmacists</b></p>	<p>This course examines the symptoms, pathophysiology, and role of pharmacists in the treatment of migraine, and introduces erenumab – a monoclonal antibody for the prevention of migraine.</p>	2
 <p><b>Cosentyx® (secukinumab): A guide for community pharmacists</b></p>	<p>Cosentyx® (secukinumab) is indicated in Australia for the treatment of plaque psoriasis, psoriatic arthritis and ankylosing spondylitis. This course provides pharmacists with important clinical information for Cosentyx® and assists pharmacists in providing support to patients being treated with Cosentyx®.</p>	2
 <p><b>Managing mild to moderate dehydration due to acute gastroenteritis</b></p>	<p>Pharmacists can play an important role in managing vomiting and diarrhoea in the pharmacy and reducing any potential dehydration. This course is intended to provide pharmacists with guidance in managing mild to moderate dehydration and recognising when referral is appropriate.</p>	2
 <p><b>Proprietary Natural Medicines: Exploring the complexity and efficacy of natural medicines</b></p>	<p>This course examines the complexity of natural medicine formulations and the principles used to ensure batch-to-batch consistency and reproducible clinically proven health outcomes for patients.</p>	2
 <p><b>Ryzodeg® 70/30 for the management of diabetes: A guide for pharmacists</b></p>	<p>Ryzodeg® 70/30 is the first insulin to combine an ultra-long acting basal insulin with a mealtime insulin in one device. This course examines the role of Ryzodeg® 70/30 in the treatment of diabetes and discusses the pathophysiology, prevalence and consequences of diabetes.</p>	3
 <p><b>Saxenda® (liraglutide) for the management of obesity: A guide for community pharmacists</b></p>	<p>Targeting the management of obesity is important due to the effect of excess weight on cardiometabolic risk factors including blood pressure, blood glucose levels and blood lipids. This course examines the clinical findings of Saxenda® (liraglutide (rys)) in the management of obesity and outlines the key counselling points that pharmacists should provide to patients prescribed Saxenda® (liraglutide (rys)).</p>	3
 <p><b>The role of community pharmacists in managing chronic pain</b></p>	<p>Chronic pain is a significant public health concern with one in five Australians living with chronic pain. This course examines the key medication options available in the treatment of chronic pain and outlines methods to assist pharmacists when communicating with patients as well as other health care professionals within the multidisciplinary team.</p>	3
 <p><b>The Burning Issue: Managing breakthrough symptoms of gastro-oesophageal reflux disease</b></p>	<p>This course examines the symptoms and treatment of gastro-oesophageal reflux disease (GORD), with a focus on the management of breakthrough heartburn symptoms.</p>	1.5



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


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
