


State of Play



24.8 million COVID-19 vaccine doses not yet given to patients


Number of COVID-19 vaccine doses yet to be given to patients, population 20 and over

As of 9 August: 676 pharmacies vaccinating



NSW: 280 out of 321 vaccinations given in Greater Sydney/Blue Mountains ACT and TAS = 0



As of 13 August: 2,470 pharmacies with stock

By the end of this week over 2,470 pharmacies should have received their AZ orders and consumables





As of 16 August: Up to 3,500 pharmacies onboarded

Over 620,000 AZ doses delivered this week

The Rollout



AstraZeneca 2nd dose bookings

- Remember to book patients in for their second dose
- In outbreak settings, shortening the gap between doses brings forward short term protection*
- Efficacy increases with longer intervals

	<6 weeks	6-8 weeks	9-11 weeks	12> weeks
Efficacy	55.1%	59.9%	63.7%	81.3 %

- Use the opportunity to ask patients if they have had their 2nd dose – freely available inhouse
- Doesn't matter where they have had their first dose encourage them to have their 2nd dose with you




Find a Pharmacy

Is your pharmacy QCPP accredited for vaccinations?

- You must be QCPP accredited at service level (Vaccination service)
- This is not an additional task if you are already vaccination accredited
- Apply for an Expansion of Services if you are not accredited at service level
- Check your email you received today for details





Are you Accredited for Vaccinations?

As pharmacies around the country join the COVID-19 Vaccination roll-out, it is a timely reminder that you must be accredited at a service level under the Quality Care Pharmacy Program in order to deliver a vaccination service in your pharmacy.

Quality Care accreditation ensures a framework is in place for the ongoing safe and quality delivery of pharmacy services to the Australian public, which remains incredibly important in this high risk environment.

If you are delivering the COVID-19 Vaccination, you must be accredited for Vaccination Services to maintain compliance with your QCPP Accreditation.

Under QCPP Rules (rule 27 and 43) and Terms and Conditions, pharmacies are not permitted to offer or advertise for a service that is not QCPP accredited. If you would like to add Vaccination Services to your QCPP accreditation, you can complete an expansion of services form below.

Apply for an Expansion of Services

If you would like to offer vaccination services and you are not currently accredited to do so, apply for an expansion of services.

Please download the form below and complete the following steps

- Complete the cover sheet indicating the services applied for, the declaration and acknowledge the payment details.
- 2. Fill-out a service information form for each service applied for



Vaccine Eligibility Checker (National Health Services Directory)

- The Department provides the National Health Services Directory (HealthDirect) with information on participating pharmacies. End of stock delivery window (Once a week)
- Short delay in uploading information due to recent acceleration
- GuildLink and MedAdvisor update booking URLs to HealthDirect (Once a week)





COVID-19 Vaccinations: State and territory requirements

State/Territory	Who can administer	Vaccines	Minimum age	Other notes/variations from normal standard
NT	 Pharmacists 	PF and AZ vaccines	 Patients aged 60 years or older (AZ) & patients 16 years or older (PF) 	 Must record patient appointment in a booking/clinical system and set up a recall for the second dose.
TAS	 Pharmacists 	AZ vaccine	Adults aged 60 years and over	 Intern pharmacists are not currently approved to administer COVID-19 vaccines.

Reminder to review patient information before vaccinating. Ensure you have checked AIR to confirm:

- Age of patient
- Vaccine history

Make sure you and your staff are trained

Make sure your pharmacists have their own professional indemnity insurance

Activate realtime AIR integration – HW027 form


