Established in 1927, the Pharmacy Guild of Australia is a membership-based organisation representing the owners of community pharmacies.

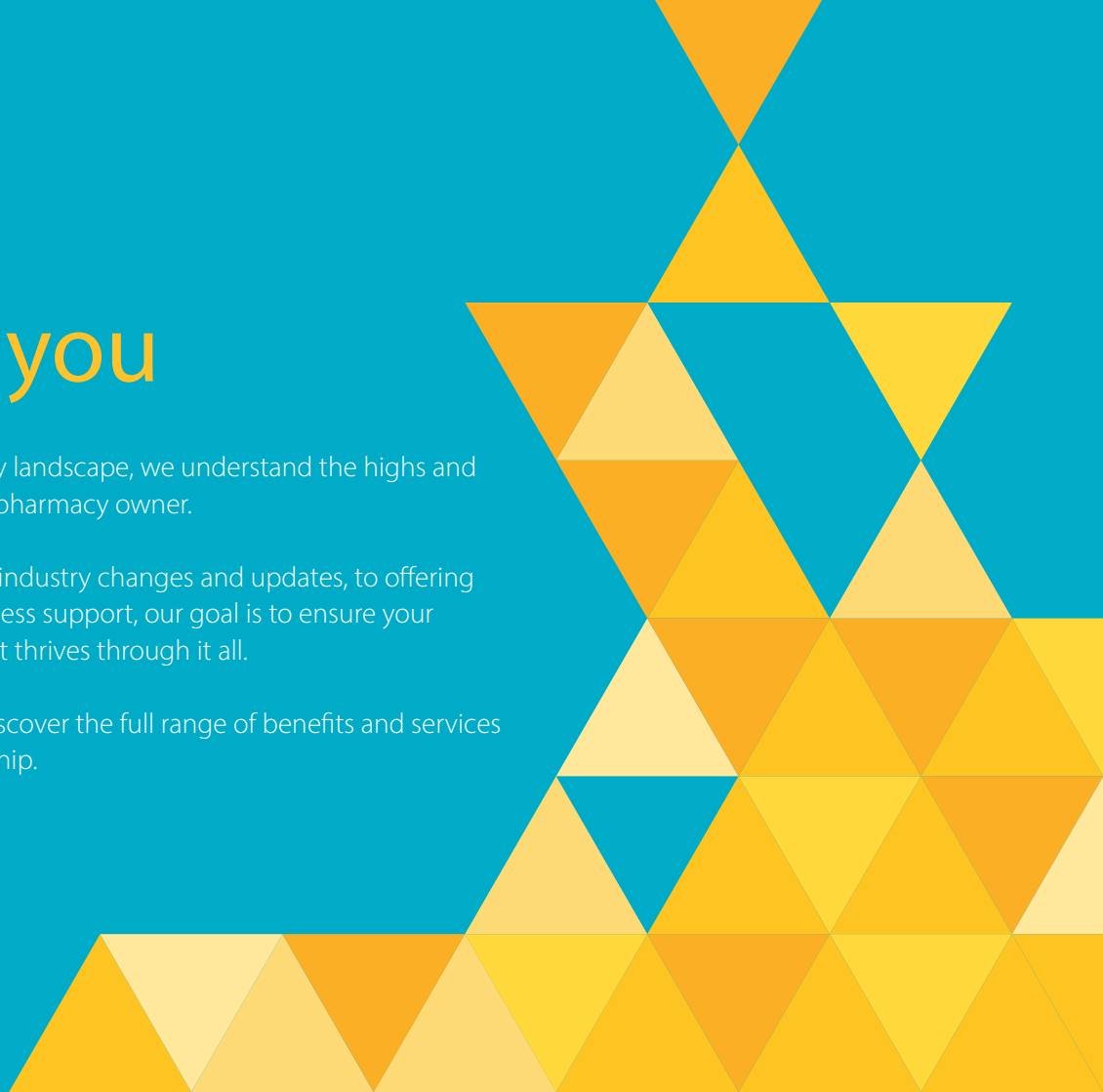
The Guild's mission is to serve the needs and preferences of patients and health consumers across Australia using pharmacy's unique role in medication management and safety.

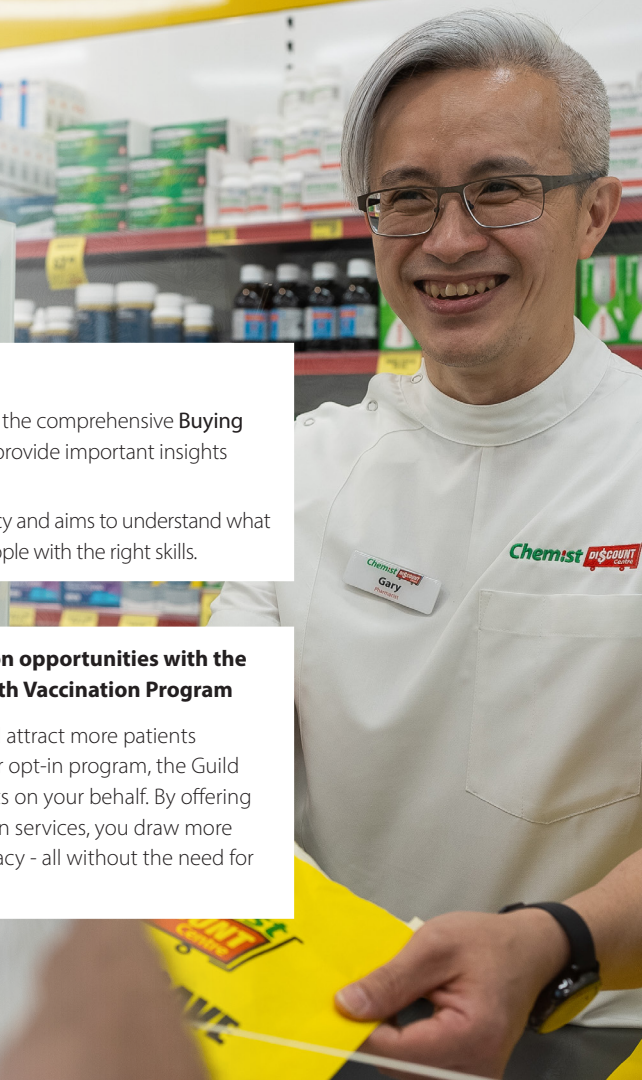

Your voice to Government

At the Guild, we lead in political advocacy, prioritising understanding the present and future challenges facing community pharmacies. This enables us to effectively represent your needs and concerns, advocating for critical issues such as ownership laws and remuneration models.

We serve as a strong advocate for the interests of community pharmacy at both local and national levels. Through state-based advocacy efforts, we work tirelessly to ensure that your voice is heard at every level of government, fighting for policies that safeguard the interests of community pharmacies.

In South Australia we have achieved:

COMMUNITY PHARMACY ORAL CONTRACEPTIVE PILL RESUPPLY SERVICES SCHEME

The Guild was instrumental in the Community Pharmacy Oral Contraceptive Pill Resupply Services Scheme implemented by the State Government.

SA COMMUNITY PHARMACY URINARY TRACT INFECTION (UTI) SERVICES

We successfully advocated and worked with the State government, for the implementation of the Urinary Tract Infection Service in Community Pharmacy.

EXPANDED SCOPE OF VACCINATION

We successfully advocated to expand the number of vaccines that can be administered by South Australian pharmacists.

THE PALLIATIVE CARE MEDICINES PHARMACY NETWORK

We successfully proposed and advocated for community pharmacy to be a part of the solution for improved access by patients, their carers and palliative care health professionals to palliative care medication. The Better Access to Palliative Care Medicines Initiative is managed by your Guild.

THE NATIONAL IMMUNISATION PROGRAM (NIPVIP)

Our work in advocating for community pharmacists as part of the National Immunisation Program (NIPVIP) is an excellent example of how better utilisation of appropriately trained health professionals can ease the burden on our health system.

FUNDED MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING FOR ALL PHARMACY STAFF

We proposed and advocated to achieve mental health first aid training for SA pharmacists and their staff, funded by the State Government.

Building public awareness

We actively engage in public-facing campaigns designed to build awareness of pharmacy by emphasising your crucial role in healthcare. Our annual flu campaigns drive patient traffic to pharmacies, seamlessly integrating with our Find a Pharmacy platform. By highlighting the expertise and services offered by pharmacies, we strive to create a deeper understanding and appreciation of the pharmacy profession among the public.

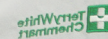
As the expansion of scope of practice continues, we also raise awareness of the new important services accessible to the public through community pharmacy.

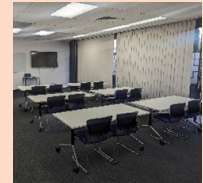
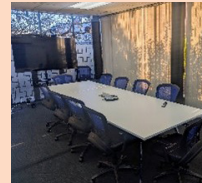
Each fortnight Guild Payroll pay over 4000 employees in the pharmacy sector.
