You only have one set of veins. If you take care of them, they'll last longer. Go slow. Be gentle.

Use the smallest needle possible.

Always

- Wash your hands and injection site before and after every injection
- > Clean your mixing equipment
- Use a new sterile needle and syringe every time
- > Learn to inject in both arms
- > Filter
- Use a wheel filter if injecting pills
- Ask NSP staff for further safer injecting information

Never

- Inject where there is redness, pain, swelling, or infection
- Jack back to flush the syringe after your shot
