What training do I need?

The Certificate III in Community Pharmacy is a recognised qualification for a pharmacy assistant working in a community pharmacy. This qualification is nationally recognised in all states and territories of Australia.

The Certificate III in Community Pharmacy will provide pharmacy assistants with foundation skills in product knowledge, health conditions and key pharmacy functions. These skills will ensure that you can provide health advice and information to customers with confidence and accuracy.

DO YOU KNOW ABOUT RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)?

RPL

Available for all qualifications, the RPL process recognises the skills and competencies gained through work experience, prior training and life experience.

Through RPL, competency may be granted for specific units within community pharmacy qualifications, meaning some pharmacy assistants can finish their course earlier than expected.

How long will the course take to complete?

The Certificate III in Community Pharmacy is a flexible course that can be tailored to meet your learning requirements and career goals.

We will work with you to develop a training plan to meet your needs and the needs of your pharmacy.

Most pharmacy assistants complete the course in less than 24 months.
