### Ian Todd awarded Barry Schultz medal

The former President of the Guild's South Australian Branch, Adelaide pharmacist Mr Ian Todd, has been awarded the Barry Schultz medal for 2014.

The medal is awarded to a pharmacist deemed to have demonstrated the qualities that made the late Barry Schultz such a distinguished pharmacist and community member.

The acting National President of the Guild, Tim Logan, said: "Ian Todd has been involved at the highest level of support and advocacy on behalf of community pharmacy for more than a decade. He is a deserved winner of this award, reflecting his commitment and contribution to our industry."
