






SIRSS00012 Community Pharmacy Dispensary (Skill Set)

Develops specialised, advanced skills for Pharmacy Assistants wanting to work in the dispensary.



Who should complete this training?

This skill set will benefit experienced pharmacy assistants who are looking to expand their skills in the area of dispensary.

Dispensary assistants work with the pharmacist to provide prescription medicines to pharmacy customers.
Under the supervision of the pharmacist, dispensary assistants maintain customer records, select and label medicines and process claims.

Accredited training can help you develop management skills and provide specialised support in the pharmacy, while granting you formal recognition of your skills.

What training do I need?

This skill set provides you with the next step in your career in community pharmacy. Community Pharmacy
Dispensary expands on the skills that you have learnt if you have previously completed community pharmacy training.



Available for all qualifications, the RPL process recognises the skills and competencies gained through work experience, prior training and life experience.

Through RPL, competency may be granted for specific units within community pharmacy qualifications, meaning some pharmacy assistants can finish their course earlier than expected.





How long will the course take to complete?

The Community Pharmacy Dispensary Skill Set can be completed in around 6 months.



What will I study?

To complete SIRSS00012 Community Pharmacy Dispensary skill set you will need to complete 6 units of competency.

What are the entry requirements?

To undertake a the Community Pharmacy Dispensary skill set you need to be employed in a Pharmacy.

The course has entry requirements which include:

- Having access to a computer or device with internet access
- A degree of digital literacy which allows you to upload documents, recordings and complete your assessments online
- Your level of english spoken and written needs to be at a level to communicate with the general community
- Your numeracy skills need to be at a level to handle money and calculate medicine doses

Minimum age requirements vary based on state legislation. Please contact us so we can discuss your state's legislation requirements.

You are able to start the Community Pharmacy Dispensary skills set as soon as you are ready.



How much will this qualification cost?

Eligibility requirements apply to government funded courses which can impact the cost of a course.

Successful completion of a course under government funding may restrict your ability to access further funding.
