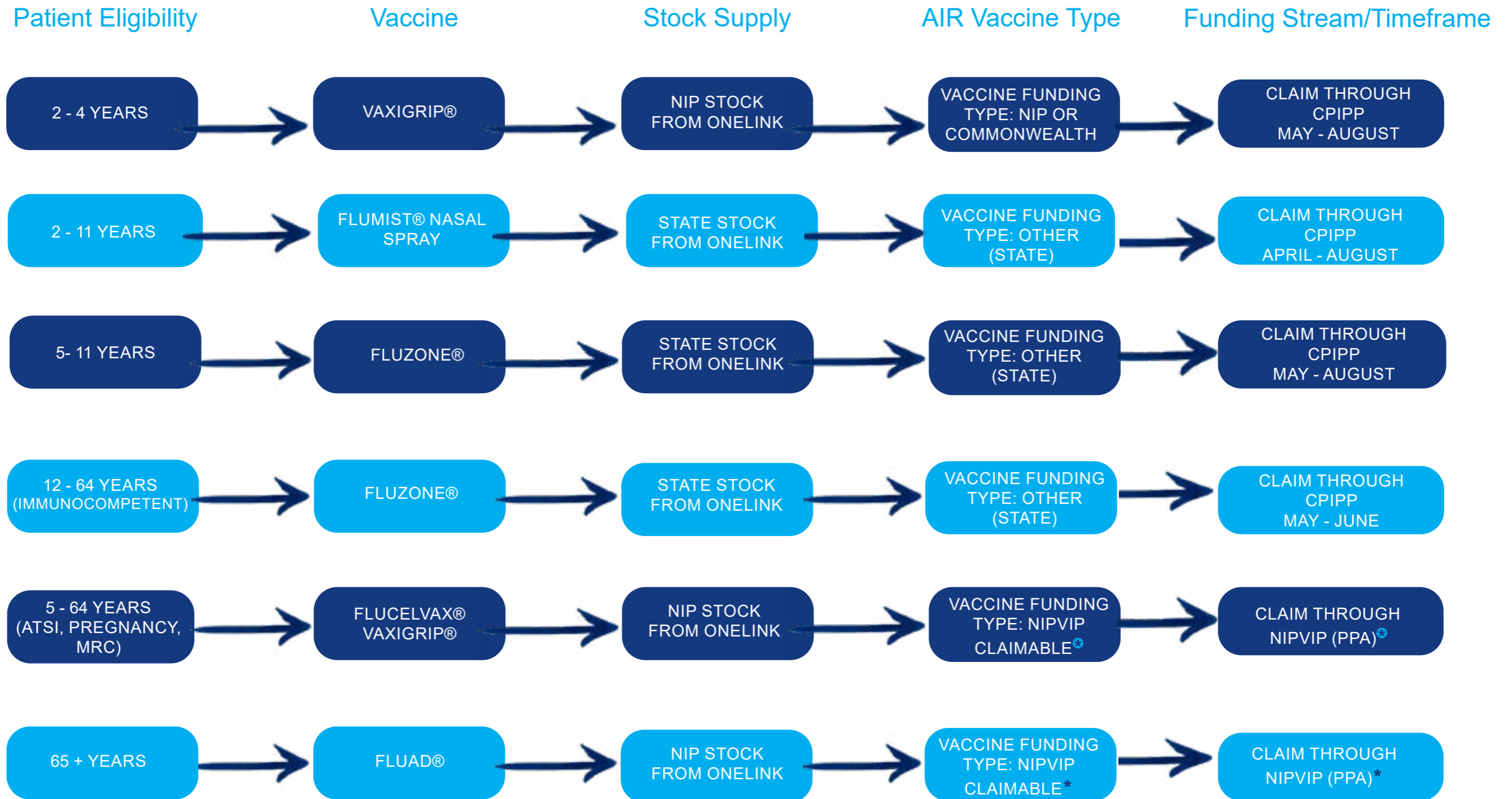

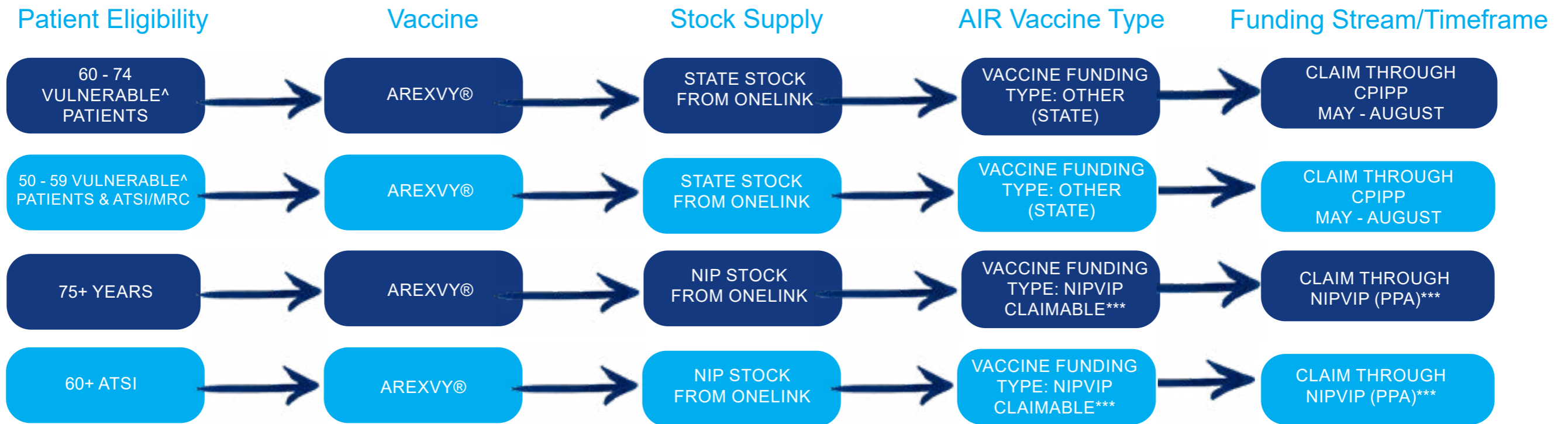

### Medical risk conditions (MRC) that increase risk of severe RSV disease in adults:

- Cardiac disease
- Chronic respiratory conditions
- Immunocompromising conditions
- Chronic metabolic disorders
- Chronic kidney disease
- Chronic neurological conditions
- Chronic liver disease
- Obesity
