# 2026 Payment amounts (ex GST) | From 20<sup>th</sup> May 2026

- **\$25.00**
  - For each privately purchased standard flu vaccine dose administered
  - Includes all non-standard influenza vaccines such as:
    - Flucelvax (6 months and older)
    - Fluzone High-Dose over 60 years old
- **\$20.05**
  - For each National Immunisation Program influenza or state funded FluMist vaccine (ages 2 to under 18) administered when a provider is not able to seek payment from a usual pathway (i.e. a National Immunisation Program Vaccination in Pharmacy payment)
- **\$14.00**
  - For the dispensing of a flu vaccine where the pharmacy requires administration to be performed by an authorised health practitioner
- **\$20.05**
  - once only for each administration of State-Funded Meningococcal B (Bexsero®) Vaccine administered by a Queensland community pharmacy to a Queensland resident who is an individual customer of that pharmacy during the Period;

# 2026 Program

- **Same as 2025 for how you record vaccination cases in MedAdvisor for Pharmacy**
- Select Infectious Disease: “Influenza (flu) or Meningococcal type B”
- **This year’s program will also be expanded with a needle-free nasal spray flu vaccine for children aged two to under eighteen years (inclusive)**
- Ensure you’re paid instore by all non eligible patients e.g. non-QLD residents
- MedAdvisor will automatically create claims – no action required
- There are no voucher codes required for input for this initiative
- Ensure you have updated your ABN, BSB and Account Number in MedAdvisor or you can’t be paid.

# Workflow

## Patient Books or Walks in

Ensure patient details, including home address, are correct in MedAdvisor

## Complete Vaccination case in MFP

Ensure the correct Vaccine Funding Type is selected: 'Other' or 'NIP and Commonwealth'

## Charging for Program

- Instore account – eligible QLD residents
- Charge directly to all other patients

## Automated Claiming

MedAdvisor will extract eligible data then will submit a claim to Qld Health for your pharmacy

MedAdvisor will receive funds then disburse payments to your pharmacy

## Reconcile

Please be careful to check that **ONLY QLD residents** have been charged to the instore account

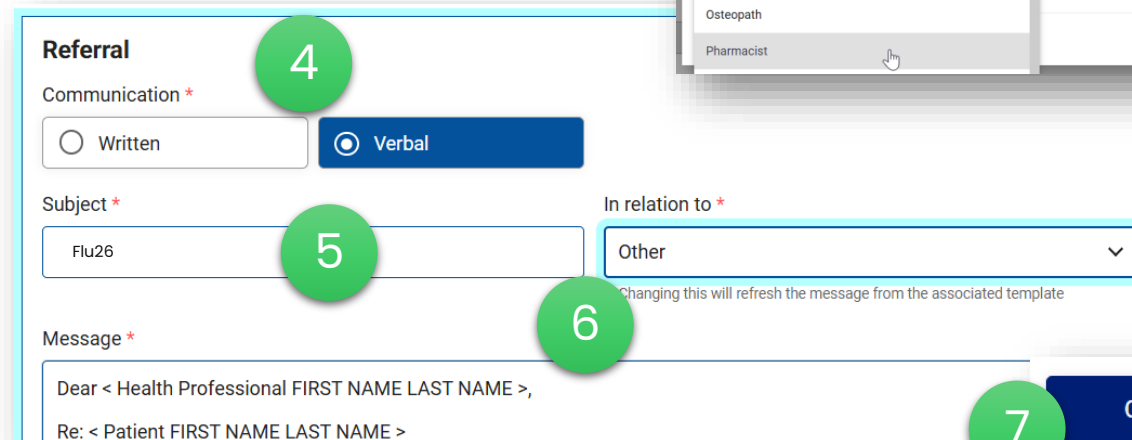
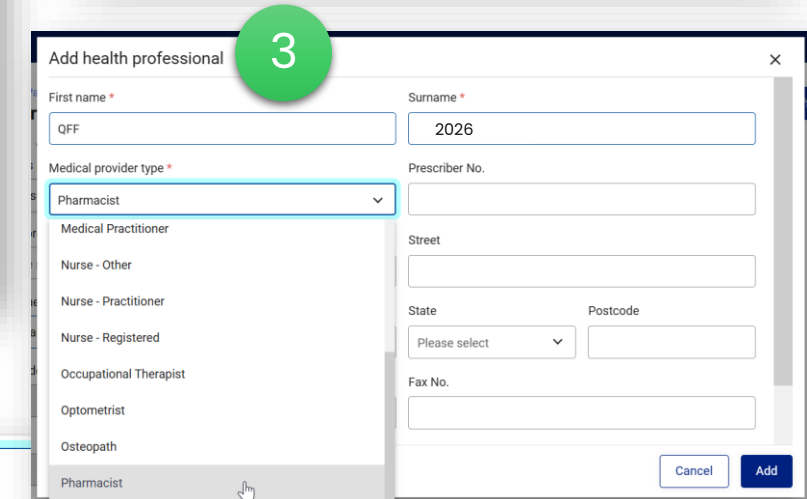
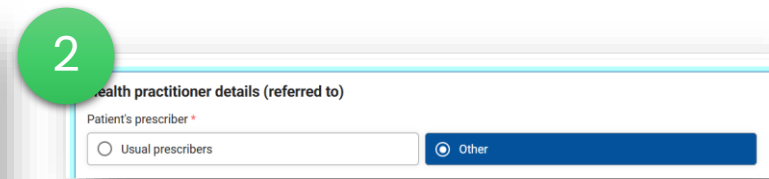
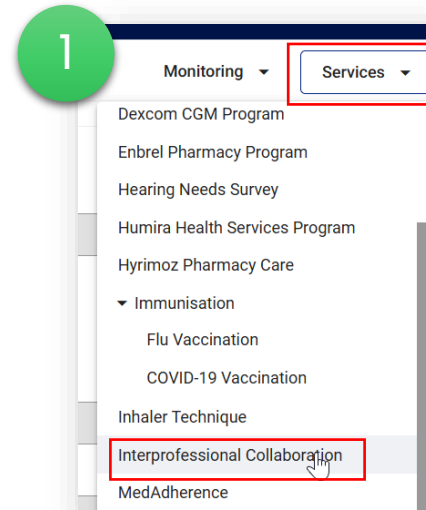
FluMist, the LAIV nasal spray (needle-free) presentation, is also available for children aged between 2 years and less than 18 years. This vaccine is available on the private market and will be available under state sponsored programs: New South Wales, Queensland and South Australia will provide FluMist for children aged 2 to up to 5 years old, whilst Western Australia will provide FluMist for children aged 2 to up to 11 years old. # Pharmacies who only supply the vaccine but do not administer

1. Use "Interprofessional Collaboration" from the Services drop down of MFP
2. Health Practitioner: choose "Other"
3. Create First name: QFF, Surname: 2026, Medical provider type: Pharmacist
4. Referral: "Verbal"
5. Subject: "Flu26"
6. In relation to: "Other"
7. Complete



# MedAdvisor Reporting to PGAQ/QH for payment

- MedAdvisor will extract data on the pharmacy's behalf including:
  - Date Range (based on date of **completion**)
  - Patient home address (QLD)
  - Infectious Disease type: Influenza or MenB
  - Vaccination Type: 'Other' or 'NIP or Commonwealth'
  - Patient Age (MenB, Flumist)
  - Interprofessional Collaboration # cases correctly recorded
- A consolidated report by pharmacy by NIP/Non-NIP by date range will be provided to the PGAQ/QH for payment
