



MedAdvisor Solutions

If your pharmacy is planning to claim payment for vaccines administered through MedAdvisor, follow the below steps to claim through the appropriate *Vaccine Funding Type*.



- 1. This option is for all patients who are **not** eligible to receive a NIP-funded vaccine and would normally pay privately for a flu vaccine. **The state will pay.**
- 2. These options are for patients who are eligible to receive a NIP-funded vaccine but because of their age (<5 years) or the location of the vaccination (i.e. **not** in the pharmacy or in an aged care or disability home) the pharmacy cannot claim remuneration from the NIPVIP Program. **The state will pay.**
- 3. This option is for patients who are eligible to receive a NIP-funded vaccine and the vaccine is given to a patient >5 years of age and in a location allowed in the <u>NIPVIP Program Rules</u>. The Commonwealth will pay.

Please note - where Commonwealth NIPVIP Program funding is available, the pharmacy must NOT claim remuneration from the State Free Flu Program.

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
